ITEM NO. 47.4.1 TO GRANT INCENTIVE TO FACULTY MEMBER WHO ACQUIRED Ph.D – REGARDING

Dr. SK Gupta, Associate Professor was promoted to Associate Professor on 2.12.2006 vide office Order No. 191 dated 7.12.2006. As he was unable to complete Ph.D within a seven years period, his increment was stopped. But he continued to get through legal stay. Now, he has been awarded with Ph.D degree on 18 April, 2019 by Panjab University, Chandigarh. As per the decision of the Board his increment was restored from the date of submission of Ph.D degree. However, he has requested to restore his annual increment from 1.12.2013 which he is drawing by the stay from Hon'ble Court.

**ITEM NO.B.47.4.3 TO RELEASE THE PAYMENT FOR THE RENOVATION
WORKS DIRECTLY TO THE EXECUTING AGENCY
(CONTRACTOR) THROUGH BSNL (CIVIL)**

The following two renovation works of the institute is in progress, which have been assigned to BSNL(Civil):

1. Old hostel (Chander Shekhar Hall) comprising of 100 room with balconies, including bathrooms, corridors and staircase etc. at Sector 26 campus of the Institute.
2. Type-III (15 Houses) and Type-IV (08 Houses), 23 Nos. faculty houses at Sector 42 campus of the Institute.

The above renovation works have come to a stand still due to non-payment of bills to executing agency by the BSNL (Civil). It was apprised by BSNL officers that the payment could not be credited to the executing agency as the payments made to BSNL got credited to their main financial head in New-Delhi, which is common for all works being executed by BSNL at various locations. The BSNL is facing financial crisis and the payments made by the institute for the renovation works are not being transferred to the executing agency, resulting which the executing agency has stopped the renovation work.

A meeting was held on 12th March, 2019 with the Chief Engineer (Civil) and Superintending Engineer (Civil) BSNL regarding the present situation of the BSNL in the Director's office (minutes of the meeting attached). During the meeting it was resolved that in order to keep the renovation works in progress and complete as per agreed time schedule BSNL(Civil) will continue to do all activities as agreed upon in the MOU and on the advice and recommendation of BSNL (Civil), the institute will release payments directly to the executing agency. However, the institute will make payments to the implementing agency on the advice and verification certificate by BSNL (Civil). During the meeting it was also resolved that if need be the existing MOU may be modified or a fresh MOU be signed by both the parties. A letter has been received from Chief Engineering (Civil), BSNL dated 11.9.2019 agreeing to modify MOU for completing the ongoing works. **Annexure – VII (Page No. 18 to 19)**

Keeping in view of the urgency of requirements of hostel and residential accommodation (under renovation), Board of Governors may kindly consider and approve the change in mode of payment also allow the amendment in the MOU.

ITEM NO. B. 47.4.4 SUPERANNUATION AGE OF SENIOR LIBRARIAN - REGARDING

Shri Manmohan Singh, Senior Librarian of the Institute filed a Civil Writ Petitioner No. 23237 of 2019 in the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, Chandigarh to allow the petitioner work till the age of 65 years of superannuation, at par with faculty in the Institute.

In the year 2003, MHRD allowed to change the Name of the Institute as National Institute of Technical Teachers Training. NITTTR Chandigarh Society in its first meeting held on 18.06.2004 framed the first rule of the NITTTR Chandigarh society. The Board resolved as under:-

"The Board resolved that the Institute may continue to follow the Government of India Rules, Regulations, orders and directions issued from time to time in respect of all the service and personnel matters, purchase procedures, administrative matters and miscellaneous matters until and unless specifically resolved otherwise and approved by the competent authority".

Ministry of Human Resource Development vied letter dated 31st December, 2008 vide clause 8(f)(ii) issued the directions for age of superannuation as under:-

"Whereas the enhancement of the age of superannuation of teachers engaged in class room teaching is intended to attract eligible persons to a career in teaching and to meet the shortage of teachers by retaining teachers in service for a longer period, and whereas there is no shortage in the categories of Librarian and Directors of Physical Education, the increase in the age of superannuation from the present sixty two years shall not be available to the categories of Librarian and Directors of Physical Education".

In the light of above the Petitioner may superannuate at the age of 62 years i.e. on 30th September, 2019.
